HOTEL FEATURES: In 1996, Morgans Hotel Group opened Mondrian, its first West Coast property. Set in the entertainment capital of the world, Mondrian offers guests a complete reinvention of the hotel experience. So much more than just a place to stay for the night, Mondrian transforms staying at a hotel into a fun, exciting and adventurous experience that lifts the spirit and touches the senses. Simple, pure, honest and real, Mondrian is also magical, mysterious and full of surprise and illusion.

Asia de Cuba, serving a refined blend of Asian and Latin cuisine, is under the direction of Jeffrey Chodorow, whose Asia de Cuba outposts in New York's Morgans and St Martins Lane in London have met with such critical and customer acclaim. This quite extraordinary space is an elegant, exciting mix of influences—a melding of simplicity and sophistication, comfort and invention.

Outdoor Areas, for use both during the day and evening; intended to stimulate all the senses, this lushly landscaped area will have scores of terra cotta pots with different seasonal flowers changed four times yearly, including arched trellises with bright pink, orange and white Bougainvillea and intermixed with Grape Vines; scented plants, including Jasmine, Lavender, Rosemary, Gardenias, Blooming Nightshade, and Roses; Climbing Ivy and Creeping Fig acting as an evergreen backdrop to the lush climbing and trailing vines; as well as vividly blooming Camellia trees, Ficus trees, Italian Cyprus trees and an enormous, multi-trunked, 150 year-old Brazilian Pepper tree. This outdoor living room provides a space that allows guests relief from the outside without actually stepping inside. Across teakwood plank flooring that recalls Coney Island, New York, and Deauville, France, are English and Indonesian teak and rattan chaise lounges and painted wicker wing chairs from the Philippines that mesh with unique furniture and objects, including: tray tables and mirrors custom-designed by Philippe Starck; from Istanbul, oversized glass and metal lanterns hang from tree boughs and glitter like fireflies echoing the twinkle of the city lights beyond; and large sculptural candles that appear to be tables and stools.

Whether enjoying a cocktail at sunset or dancing away a Saturday night, perennial LA hotspot Skybar is a splendid escape from the teeming Sunset Strip. Nestled in Mondrian's courtyard, the newly renovated Skybar has been reconceived by Tim Andreas of BANJO as the ultimate LA lounge. During the day it is a relaxing spot for a mid-afternoon snack or refreshing drink; at night the party starts. The open-air hut sparkles with custom-designed furniture handmade in San Miguel de Allende, Mexico; luxurious lounge seating with accents of yellow and gold; and unique reflective glass surfaces evoking the Pacific Ocean. Downstairs by the pool, intimate seating areas provide a special place to spend an evening with the glistening LA skyline as backdrop.
